BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- The North Carolina League of Municipalities is a member-driven organization representing the interests of cities and towns in the state. Through their collective efforts, League member cities and towns better serve their residents and improve quality of life. For more than 100 years, the League has been one voice for cities and towns working for a better North Carolina.

SUMMARY

- One of the League's most important responsibilities is representing the municipal viewpoint before the General Assembly, the U.S. Congress and administrative rule-making authorities. To effectively lobby and advocate for what's in the best interest for cities, towns, and their residents, our Public and Government Affairs staff works directly with legislators, government agencies and employees, and other policymakers to ensure that municipal officials are involved in the process of setting policies and rules affecting municipal operations.
- The League adopts is legislative priorities every biennium. The adopted goals serve as the advocacy priorities for North Carolina's municipalities.
- For 2023-2024, the League Board of Directors has recommended 16 goals for consideration.
- Each municipality is requested to vote for their top 10 (of the recommended 16 goals).

- Review and identify the top 10 legislative priorities for the Town of Knightdale.
- Instruct the Town Manager to submit the vote for the Town.
