PURPOSE

To adopt the following Council Policies required for ARPA funding: Record Retention, Nondiscrimination, and Conflict of Interest.

STAFF DISCUSSION

These policies are related to the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds.

Record Retention: Supplements the Town's current Records Retention Policy to establish procedures to retain all ARPA related information for at least 5 years.

Nondiscrimination: Reaffirms the Town's commitment to compliance with federal civil rights laws and establishes processes for reporting potential violations and tracking complaints and resolutions.

Conflict of Interest: Requires recipients and subrecipients of federal financial assistance to maintain written standards of conduct covering conflicts of interest and governing the actions of its employees engaged in the selection, award, and administration of contracts.
