- 5. PLANNING BOARD
 - a. ZTA-2-24: Quarterly Update

Donna Goodman, Senior Planner- Long Range and Sustainability, presented the proposed amendments to Unified Development Ordinance which include changes to accessory dwelling units (ADU), contractor office use, and mixed use building standards. A joint public hearing was held on April 18th, 2024 where no comments were received from the public. Proposed Unified Development Ordinance amendments will be brought before the May 15th, 2024 Town Council meeting for decision.

Staff recommended advisory statement:

The proposed zoning text amendment is consistent with the KnightdaleNext 2035 Comprehensive Plan's goal of determining effective public policy that provides an ongoing framework for informed and directed public investment and private development. Further, it is reasonable and in the public interest as it helps to achieve the Affordable Knightdale recommendation to expand housing options, clarifies community design standards, and provides clear guidance to business owners. Motion to recommend approval of ZTA-2-24 and forward the staff recommended advisory statement of plan consistency to Town Council Motion by Member Ronald Cole Seconded by Member Taylor Norton

b. ZTA-3-24: Stormwater Update

Ike Archer, Stormwater Program Manager, presented on amendments to the Unified Development Ordinance including updating the stormwater management permit expiration, incorporation of the Neuse River Nutrient Management Strategy, and removal of replacement fund payment requirements for stormwater control measures (SCM) devices. Proposed amendments are a result of North Carolina General Statute changes. A joint public hearing was held on April 18, 2024 and received no comments from the public.

Staff recommended advisory statement:

The proposed zoning text amendment is consistent with the KnightdaleNext 2035 Comprehensive Plan's goal of determining effective public policy that provides an ongoing framework for informed and directed public investment and private development. Further, it is reasonable and in the public interest as it aligns the Town's Unified Development Ordinance with the North Carolina General Statutes and clarifies environmental development regulations for property owners and developers.
