ORDINANCE # 25-08-20-001

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT THE INTERSECTION OF PARKSIDE COMMONS DRIVE AND VILLAGE PARK DRIVE

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute §20-158, enables municipalities to install traffic control devices including but not limited to stop signs on three or more approaches to an intersection for roadways within the town; and

WHEREAS, local streets and roads are maintained by the Town of Knightdale; and

WHEREAS, Parkside Commons Drive is a local street within the Town of Knightdale; and

WHEREAS, the authorization of a all-way stop control intersection of Parkside Commons Drive and Village Park Drive meets with the standards from the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) section 2B.17 where conversion to all-way stop control is expected to improve traffic operational characteristics of the intersection and pedestrian and/or bicyclist movements support the installation of all-way stop control.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Knightdale, North Carolina:

SECTION 1: That Title VII, Chapter 70 "Traffic Regulations", Section 70.01 "Traffic and Parking Regulations", subsection (a) of the Knightdale Code be amended by reference to read as follows:

1. That the intersection Parkside Commons Drive and Village Park Drive be designated as an all-way stop control intersection with stop signs on all intersecting streets.

SECTION 2: That all laws and clauses of law in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION 3: That if this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provision of this ordinance which can be given separate effect and to the end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4: That this ordinance shall be enforced as provided in N.C.G.S 160A-175 or as provided for in the Knightdale Town Code.

SECTION 5: That this ordinance shall take full effect upon adoption and following the posting of new signage and pavement marking along Parkside Commons Drive at the subject intersection.
